PROPOSED LABOUR WARD RENOVATIONS

We wish to inform the prequalified contractors that we have complied feedback on the clarifications below regarding the above tender advertised on **Tuesday, 23rd January 2024**.

No.	Clarification	Feedback
1.	Sub-contract Model - Will it be a domestic or a nominated sub-contract arrangement? If the former is true, is there need to subject the individual sub-contractors to an evaluation? Why not evaluate the MC for the specialist works and let the MC take direct responsibility for the subs.	Yes The Subcontractors will be domestic. All the sub-contractors proposed by the Main Contractor must meet the qualification criteria set at the relevant category. Failure to meet the criteria by one subcontractor will lead to disqualification of the entire bid.
2.	If indeed the arrangement is domestic, why then request the subs to provide proof of purchase of tender yet they are domestic? Isn't the MC's proof sufficient?	The Main Contractor's proof of payment is sufficient. The subcontractors need not pay neither provide proof of the same.



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3.	Similarly, on the site Visit form. Is the MCs evidence sufficient? In any case none of them attended the site visit. It's the MCs who did.	Yes, the Main Contractors evidence of site visit is sufficient.
4.	In the evaluation of subs, a sub is expected to score at least 35/50. What happens in the event the MC passes well but one of its subs fails to meet this requirement? Will the successful MC be given a chance to replace the Sub? Is it possible to let the MC be the one responsible for all his sub-contractors so that the evaluation is 1 step process given that it is domestic arrangement?	All the Subcontractors must meet the minimum score as set out in the tender. Failure to achieve the minimum qualification by a subcontractor will lead to disqualification of the entire bid
