- c) Prepare and package chemotherapy medications and other medications requiring special handling in accordance with safety measures;
- d) Assist in filling, processing, and dispensing medications to patients in safety standards and to ensure quality care for patients;
- e) Assist in maintaining the drug inventory through inventory control practices;
- f) Initiate procurement process for medications;
- g) Check for expiration dates on medications on a regular basis;
- h) Record and maintain accurate reports and paper work on all transactions; and
