- Providing expertise on the hospital wide committee on AMR, Infection control, etc.
- Supervising quality checks both internal and external and sign off to ensure the department is performing to the required quality standards & complying to quality assurance requirements to ensure the accuracy and reliability of test results.
- Come up with innovative test methods for new conditions that deliver quality patient care and output.
- Develop & monitor Test verification / Validation protocols.
- Develop testing strategy and laboratory protocols during epidemics and pandemics;
