- Evaluate patients' medical histories to ensure the various medical imaging procedures will not harm them and recommend alternative medical imaging techniques, where necessary.
- Communicate the medical imaging process to patients in line with requirements.
- Supervise examinations on patients using computer tomography (CT) scanners, magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) and fluoroscopy and provide technical findings on test results for use in diagnosis and treatment.
- Perform and/or guide radiology staff to carry out image-guided diagnostic procedures in line with established protocols.
- Interpret patients' test results from diagnostic imaging procedures to determine accurate diagnoses.
- Communicate and discuss results and diagnoses with physicians.
- Compile reports on test results and diagnoses.
- Carry out emergency procedures on patients in line with medical protocols in case of resuscitations, bleeding, or infections among others as and when required.
- Participate in research activities in radiology in line with set objectives.
- Participate in the development and review of protocols in the radiology department; and
