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Objective:

Scope:

6. **Monitoring and Analysis:** Monitoring, measurement and analysis of energy management performance through internal and external energy audits in order to identify opportunities for improvement.
7. **Continuous Improvement:** Continual improvement of the suitability, adequacy and effectiveness of energy management programmes.
