- Accountability:** Ensuring employee’s individual as well as collective responsibility for the effectiveness of the Environmental Management System.
- Communication:** Communication of this policy to staff and other stakeholders and relevant interested parties.
- Continuous Improvement:** Continual improvement of the Environmental Management System.
